## Each Story Contains

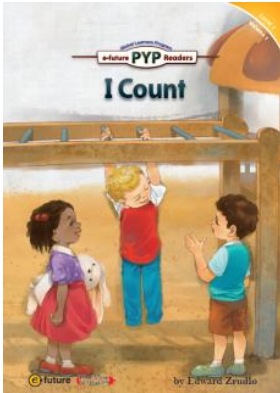
- Characters authentic in behavior and attitude to children at the same age and developmental level as the readers.

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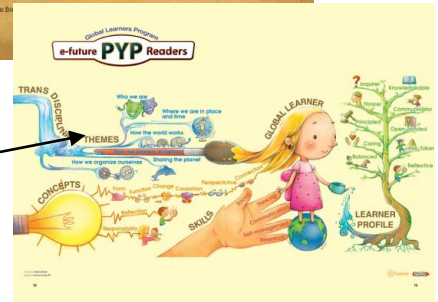
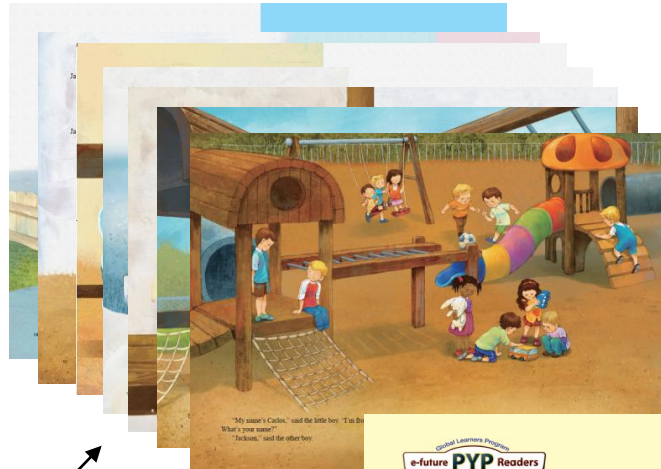

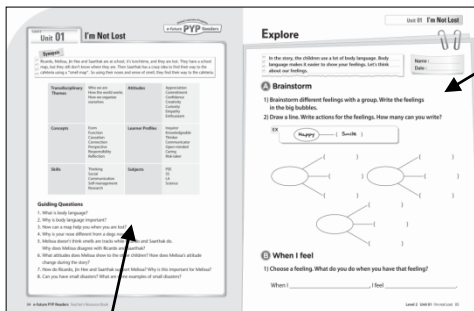

**Teacher's Resource Books**

e-future PYP Readers Teacher's Resource Book includes four pages of resources for each volume in the series. These pages include a teacher's page, an explore page, a reflect page, and an apply page.



**Teacher's Page**  
 Where teachers can find a synopsis of the story, information on the story's connection to a PYP, and get guiding questions that they can ask in class.

**Explore Page**  
 Where students explore a theme in the stories by brainstorming, researching and sharing what they know.

**Apply Page**  
 Where students apply their skills and use their existing and new knowledge to share something they have learned.

**Reflect Page**  
 Where students reflect on how their personal experiences connect with a particular theme that appears in the story. They also have the chance to share their thoughts with others.
