Series Overview

e-future PYP Readers is based around three simple principles: **explore, reflect and apply through literature**. It is a six-level series of readers that are designed to complement any inquiry-based classroom setting, particularly aimed at primary years programs. Each book contains beautiful illustrations that support deeper comprehension of the readings, while engaging learners in high-interest learning content. The content in the stories crosses a wide number of curricular topics allowing teachers to easily coordinate material for specific learning needs.

Series Chart

Level: Title	Volumes	Story Arc
Level 1: About Me	12 Volumes	A group of students explore who they are and how they interact with the world.
Level 2: Outside Discovery	12 Volumes	Students learn to appreciate individual differences while seeking answers to how the universe functions.
Level 3: Fabulous Field Trip	12 Volumes	Together students learn to appreciate personal differences while learning about animals, plants and insects.
Level 4: Edventureland	12 Volumes	A group of students share culture and personal experiences while mastering the unexpected risks of Edventureland.
Level 5: Tropical Wonder	12 Volumes	A group of students volunteer their time to help save endangered animals while learning valuable information about our fragile world.
Level 6: Venture Quest	12 Volumes	Together students explore historical and cultural differences while overcoming the many obstacles the adventure camp Venture Quest has to offer.

Series Components

- 6 levels of readers
- 12 illustrated volumes per level
- 1 activity-rich Teacher's Resource Book per level

Each Story Contains

- Characters that demonstrate authentic attitudes and behaviors
- Natural speech that is age appropriate
- Adventures and situations that highlight and encourage curiosity and exploration
- Illustrations that reflect learners' imaginative and creative minds
- Themes related to science, culture and folklore

About the Books

e-future PYP Readers have been designed with classroom teaching in mind. At the beginning of each book, a quick reference chart is provided to help teachers and administrators see how the story can be used with inquiry-based primary years programs. The body of the book is made up of thirteen pages of exciting character-driven narrative to keep learners engaged while reading. At the end of each book, a conceptual map reminds teachers and students of the overall goals of inquiry-based learning programs.

The Chart

The Story

- 13-page illustrated story

Teacher's Resource Books

The **Teacher's Resource Book** includes a series overview with quick classroom activities, four pages of resources for each volume in the series, and a set of writing pages for the classroom. The resource pages include a teacher's page, an explore page, a reflect page, and an apply page.

Teacher's Page

Where teachers can find a story synopsis, a chart connecting the story to primary years programs and guiding questions that explore deeper meaning.

Explore Page

Where students explore ideas connected to specific content areas, story concepts, and previously acquired knowledge through brainstorming and group discussions.

Reflect Page

Where students reflect on their personal experiences and how they relate to action, content, or interpersonal experiences in the story through creative sharing activities.

Apply Page

Where students apply their prior and acquired knowledge in skill oriented research pages that build an understanding of the writing and presenting process.

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
